Preparing for you Comprehensive Exam

Preparation begins at the start of PPS-I and continues throughout the PPS courses culminating with this Comprehensive Exam. This is a take home exam. Note carefully the advice provided in your manual about how to use the exercise pages fully. Make the most of all learning opportunities on the course, during observation and at home.

Prepare and use the study and learning tools. Work regularly with flash cards, DVD's, manual and summaries for each assessment section of the course. This will help you easily recall important and pertinent facts. With repetitive use of these tools, you will build your confidence and reinforce your memory.

Maintain routines in the days before the assessment. Go through your manual, notes, learning and study tools. This will reactivate the memories of all the knowledge and skills learned.

The Comprehensive Assessment includes assessment of theoretical knowledge. The 100- question multiple choice exam is broken down as follows:

- I. **General Information** – (8 questions) Benefits, Vocabulary, Pathway of Learning, Historical Information, General Questions about the 5 Part Formula and how it relates to teaching.
- II. **Mind Body Spirit Connection:** (4 questions) Peak Principles, MBS Connection.
- III. **Presentation Skills:** (10 questions) Safety, Exercise Delivery, Teacher's Posture, Touch Techniques, Professionalism, Teacher Mindfulness
- IV. **Teaching:** (15 questions) session format (order & timing), teaching methodology (set up, springs and reps, execution flow, cueing, rhythm, voice, breath dynamics), imagery, art of communication, do's and don'ts, shapes in space, building blocks, and questions from special cases chart.
- V. **Progression:** (10 questions) guidelines, understanding progression, series, why the order, art of progression, signs of readiness chart, fundamentals, and reading bodies/individual needs.
- VI. **Exercise Technique:** (15 questions) Technique from exercise pages, transitions, exercise goals, precision points, common errors, common weakness and solutions charts.
- VII. **Case Studies** (28 questions) Practical application of the Pilates system using all apparatus.
